

## How to Make a Reed Diffuser

Newspaper

Paper towel

## **Equipment Include:**

- Diffuser base oil
- Diffuser bottle
- Reed diffuser sticks
- Measuring cup
- Warning label
- Fragrance oil
- Measuring jug
- Mixing stick

## Directions:

Line your work area with newspaper before beginning the process. <u>Diffuser base oil, if spilt, will</u> <u>damage bench tops.</u>

- Measure the volume of the diffuser bottle by filling it with water until ¾ full and pour the water into a measuring jug. This is the volume of the bottle.
  In this kit, the volume of the diffuser bottle is 350ml (¾ full).
- Using the measuring cup provided, measure 55ml of the fragrance, pour it into the measuring jug, and mix with the stick for at least 30 seconds. <u>Use between 15 and 20%</u> (based on the volume of the bottle) of fragrance oil.
- 3. Pour the blend (**diffuser base oil + fragrance**) into **the diffuser bottle** until it is ¾ full (295ml base oil). <u>DO NOT OVERFILL THE BOTTLE</u>.
- 4. Clean up any liquid dripping onto the diffuser bottle with **a paper towel**.
- 5. Paste **the warning label** on the base of the diffuser bottle.
- 6. Insert the **knob lid** into the **bottle** for storage. Ensure the plug is tight to prevent spillage.
- 7. When ready to be used, remove **knob lid**, and insert **5 to 10 reed diffuser sticks** into the bottle.
- 8. Once **reed diffuser sticks** soak up the oil, fragrance will be dispersed.
- 9. Flip reed diffuser sticks once a week.
- 10. Change reed diffuser sticks every 3 to 6 months.
- Please note that these instructions are generic.
- Never fill diffuser bottle to the full capacity.
- Use diffuser oil with caution as if spilled, will damage benchtops, tables, and surfaces.
