

How to Make A Diffuser

Tools Needed:

- Diffuser base oil
- Diffuser bottle
- Reed diffuser sticks
- Candle fragrance oil
- Measuring cup
- Measuring jug

Directions:

1. Line your work area with newspaper before beginning process. Diffuser base oil if spilled will damage bench tops
2. Measure the volume of the diffuser bottle by filling it with water until $\frac{3}{4}$ full and pour the water into a measuring jug. This is the volume of the bottle.
3. In this kit, the volume of the diffuser bottle is 200ml.
4. Using the measuring cup provided, measure 30ml of fragrances and carefully pour it into the diffuser bottle.
5. Use between 15-20% (based on volume of bottle) of fragrance oil
6. Pour diffuser base oil into diffuser bottle until it is $\frac{3}{4}$ full and stir well to fully dissolve fragrance oil. DO NOT OVER FILL BOTTLE
7. Clean up any diffuser oil that has dripped onto the diffuser bottle with paper towel
8. Paste warning label on the base of diffuser bottle or on the gift box
9. If giving as a gift, insert clear plastic plug into the bottle. Ensure plug is tight to prevent spillage.
10. When ready to be used, remove plastic plug and insert 5 reed diffuser sticks into bottle.
11. Once reed diffuser sticks soak up the oil, fragrance will be dispersed.
12. Flip reed diffuser sticks once a week.
13. Change reed diffuser sticks every 2-3 weeks.

- Please note that these instructions are generic
- Never fill diffuser bottle to the full capacity
- Use diffuser oil with caution as if spilled, will damage benchtops, tables and surfaces
