

## Kaiser Wax Colour Pastilles

### TECHNICAL DATA SHEET

#### DESCRIPTION:

Kaiser Wax Colour comes in a pastille form and is a colouring agent for candle wax. It has an insertion temperature of 80°C to 85°C and gives a strong, brilliant, shiny colour. It has a good burning behaviour and good colour stability. Recommend dosage is 0.1% -0.2% (0.1%-0.4% for black). It is dust free and leaves no residue. Stir through until completely dissolved which can take up to 5 mins, otherwise colour will not be completely incorporated into wax. If pastilles are crushed, they will stain. Please refer to online SDS before use, or available on request at counter.

\*This is a guide only, always test colour first. The type of wax used will affect the outcome of the colour.

#### HEATING:

Blending temperature is 80°C to 85°C. Do not overheat as spots can form.

#### INSTRUCTIONS:

Add to liquefied wax when temperature is 80°C to 85°C. Stir through until completely dissolved and incorporated (about 5 mins). Add fragrance if desired. Pour wax at its recommended pouring temperature.

#### TYPICAL PROPERTIES:

Blending temperature:	80°C to 85°C
Agitation:	up to 5 mins
Recommended dosage:	0.1%-0.2% (0.1%-0.4% for black)

#### NOTE:

Always keep in containers of same material as the original one. Keep in cool, dry place, avoid direct sunlight. Keep at temperature not exceeding 30°C.
